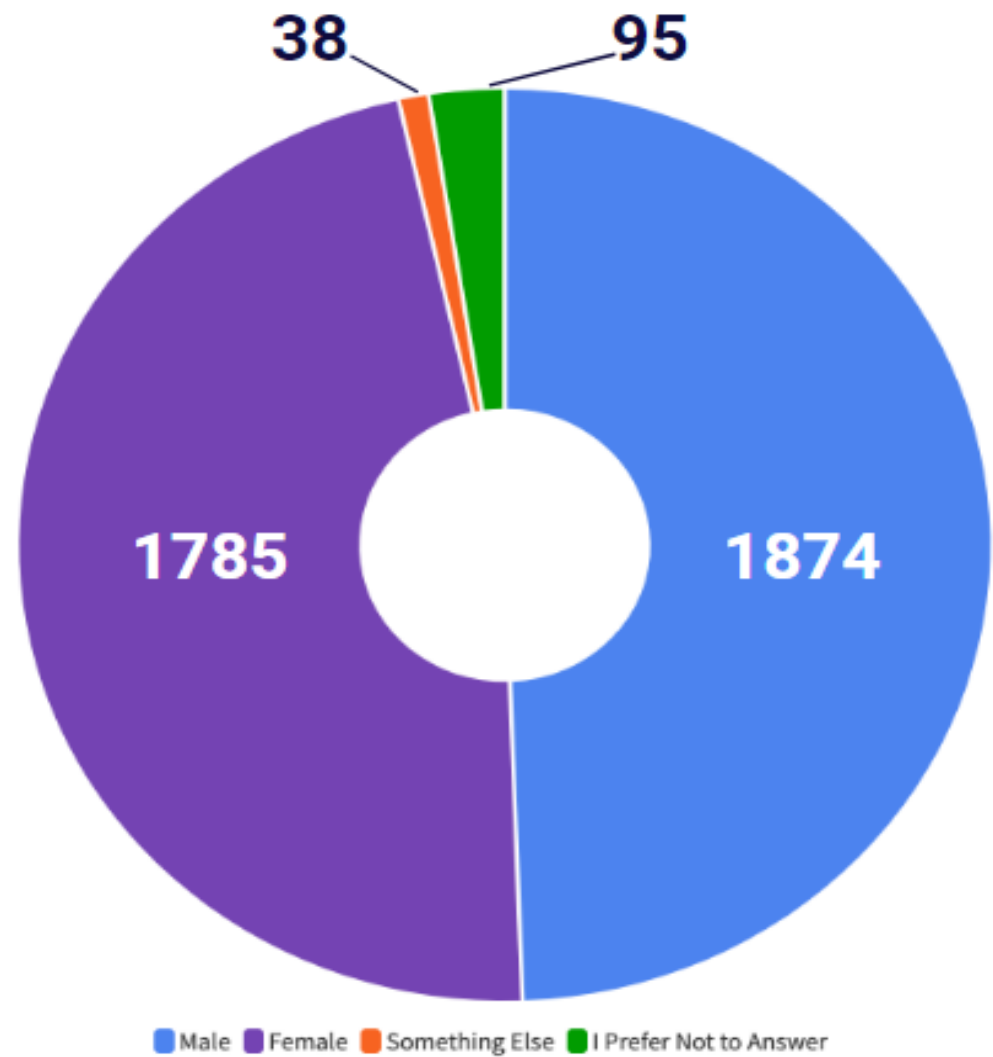




2023 Greenwich Together Youth
Survey Findings:
Selected Data for Nonbinary Youth

INTRODUCTION

This Appendix to the 2023 Greenwich Together Youth Survey represents selected data and observations for the 4% of the respondents to the Survey who did not identify themselves in the male/female gender binary. These youth answered the gender question either "Something Else" or "I Prefer Not to Answer." This group represents 133 of the total respondents of 3,792.



PROTECTIVE FACTORS

- 35.38% of non-binary respondents strongly disagreed or somewhat disagreed with the statement “I feel safe in my community,” while only 7.15% of male/female respondents disagreed with these statements. (Question 12)

- 17.30% of non-binary respondents strongly disagreed or somewhat disagreed with the statement “My parent/guardian love and support me,” while only 4.36% of male/female respondents disagreed with these statements. (Question 11)

ADDITIONAL PROTECTIVE FACTORS

16.38% of non-binary respondents “felt not at all connected to the youth in their school,” while only 6.25% of male/female respondents felt this way. (Question 46)

23.48% of non-binary respondents “felt not at all connected to the adults outside of school,” while only 10.34% of male/female respondents felt this way. (Question 46)

27.19% of non-binary respondents “felt not at all connected to the community where they live,” while 12.29% of male/female respondents felt this way. (Question 46)

RISK FACTORS

46.61% of non-binary respondents answered that "in the last 30 days, they have frequently felt anxious," while 27.08% of male/female respondents answered this way. (Question 40)

36.44% of non-binary respondents answered that "in the last 30 days, they have frequently felt sad or depressed," while 14.08% of male/female respondents answered this way. (Question 40)

03

38.14% of non-binary respondents answered that "in the last 30 days, they have frequently felt lonely," while 14.15% of male/female respondents answered this way. (Question 40)

ADDITIONAL RISK FACTORS

31.58% of non-binary respondents answered that "in the last 12 months, they had been bullied on school property," while 14.17% of male/female respondents answered this way. (Question 48)

26.32% of non-binary respondents answered that "in the last 12 months, they had been bullied outside of school property," while 11.88% of the male/female respondents answer this way. (Question 48)

28.70% of the non-binary respondents answered that "in the last 12 months, they have been electronically bullied," while 13.74% of the male/female respondents answered this way. (Question 48)
